Subject: AudioSuite mystery solved

Hello students,

As many of you know, the non-real-time AudioSuite plug-ins (i.e. normalization, reverse, pitch shift, etc) have had some display issues (i.e. a white box instead of the plug-in). It turns out that the video card doesn't support these on the second monitor once they have been closed. To fix this problem:

Move the box to the right monitor by clicking on the white line at the top of the plug-in box and drag it. Close it. When you re-open it, it should work properly. Such an easy fix...
